The Irish Air Line Pilots' Association (IALPA) represents 1,200 professional pilots in Ireland. Our members are spread across a wide range of employers eg Aer Lingus, ASL, CityJet, Stobart Air, Ryanair and CHC. CHC provide the Search & Rescue services (SAR) to the Irish Coast Guard. Indeed two of the 4 crew members who tragically lost their lives in the Rescue 116 accident off the Mayo coast last year were members of IALPA.

You may be aware from some media reports that members of IALPA employed by Ryanair in Ireland are currently balloting for industrial action up to and including strike action. The ballot is being conducted in accordance with the provisions of the 1990 Industrial Relations Act. In the event that the ballot meets the standard of the 1990 Act it will be the intention of IALPA members to picket the main entrance to the Dublin Airport campus. The dates for the strike are not yet finalised but we contemplate a series of one or two day strikes during the months July and August. The earliest legal date we could be picketing the Airport is Tuesday 10 July 2018 however, this date is not yet finalised.
